

Tour to Tartu-city of good thoughts

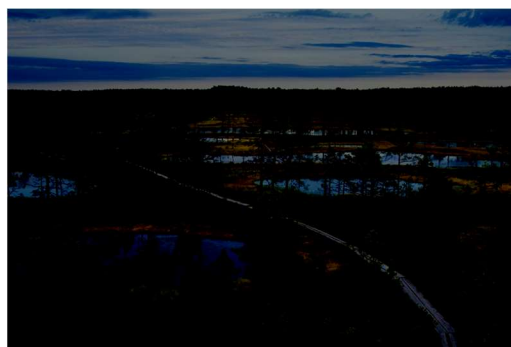
