Created by Peter the Great, St Petersburg was intended from its inception as a display of imperial Russia's growing status in the world. Fine-tuned by Peter's successors, who employed a host of European architects to add fabulous palaces and cathedrals to the city's layout, St Petersburg grew to be the Romanovs' showcase capital and Russia's first great, modern city.

During 3-day tour we will explore the most important sights of St Petersburg, Hermitage, Tsarskoje Selo, Vitebsky railway station, Catherine Palace with Amber room, parks and palaces.
